

Welcome to Green Lake Community Center

As you may have heard in recent months, the City of Seattle faced a 2011 budget shortfall of \$67 million. This meant serious budget reductions in almost every City department, including Parks and Recreation.

One result of those reductions affects Green Lake Community Center by reducing its weekly operating hours to 35 hours in 2011. It is now known as a "limited use center."

**Beginning January 3, 2011, the center will be open:
Monday-Friday, 1 to 8 p.m.**

We are pleased to be able to keep the center open for you; however, the reductions also mean significantly limited staffing. Programs operated by the Associated Recreation Council (preschool) will continue. Parks staff will be available only during operating hours to accept payments and registrations. Northgate Community Center at (206) 386-4283 can also assist you with payments and registration during their operating hours.

Outside of Green Lake Community Center's operating hours, the building will still be available for rentals and some programs requiring registration. If you have an event scheduled and cannot get in, please call the Park Duty Officer at 206-982-4583.
